- Exhibitors:** Any grower may enter for ribbons and trophies.
- Show Entry Times:** Thursday, February 5, 2009 from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m..  
Friday, February 6, 2009 from 12:00 noon to 5:00 p.m..  
No show plant may leave the show before 5:00 on Sunday February 8.  
There will be no exceptions to the closing time on Friday.  
The Malihini Orchid Society February meeting will be held between 6:00 and 7:00 p.m. on Friday, February 6, 2009 as a show preview.  
There will be a hors d'oeuvre & dessert potluck on show preview night.
- Classes of Exhibitors** Amateur - one who has won between 0 and 3 trophies at any orchid show.  
Intermediate - one who has won between 4 and 15 trophies at any orchid show.  
Advanced - one who has won 16 or more trophies at any orchid show.
- General Rules**
1. Your entry card must be filled out correctly. The plant name or parentage is required.
  2. You need not be a member of Malihini Orchid Society to enter.
  3. All plants and flowers are exhibited at the exhibitor's risk.
  4. No plant may be entered for ribbon or trophy judging unless it has been owned and grown by the exhibitor for at least six months.
  5. Plants entered for AOS judging are governed by the AOS rules. AOS rules state that all plants submitted at an AOS sanctioned show shall be considered for an award, and the exhibitor is obliged to accept and pay the fee for any award granted, except where it is clearly indicated before the judging, that the entry is NOT to be AOS Judged.
  6. Plants entered for CSA judging are governed by CSA rules.
  7. Only Group H and 1st bloom seedlings may be entered in more than one class.
